REGISTRATION/ENROLMENT

Before lacing up those dancing shoes, it is important that all students and/or parents – whether returning or new – fill out and sign your enrolment paperwork so we can ensure we have the most up-to-date contact details for you. This information includes your registration details, photo consent (so we can show off photos and videos of our amazing dances in and around the studio), and indemnity clause.

You can register online at www.dodance.com.au/registration or in person at our reception desk at the studio during the school term.

Our annual registration fee is \$37.50 per student/per year and must be paid in full prior to the commencement of classes. Make sure you get your payment in via PayPal, Internet Transfer, EFTPOS, Credit Card, Cash or Cheque as failure to pay your registration fee in time may result in losing your place in the class.

We encourage all our students and families to try a variety of dance styles and we are more than happy to accommodate a free trial class for students who are wanting to try something a bit different. CANCELLATION OF ENROLMENT

All student enrolments are valid from their Date of Registration until 28th November 2026. If you decide to discontinue your enrolment prior to 28th November 2026, 14 days' notice is required in writing to admin@dodance.com.au. All fees will be payable until such notice is given in writing.

COMPLAINTS & CONCERNS

Do Dance Academy encourages open communication and takes all complaints and concerns seriously. Children, parents, carers, staff and community members have the right to raise concerns if something does not feel safe or appropriate.

Children are encouraged to speak to a teacher or trusted adult at the studio if something makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe. Parents and carers can raise concerns by contacting the Studio Principal directly via reception or email.

All concerns are handled sensitively, confidentially and in the best interests of the child. No person will be disadvantaged for raising a concern in good faith.

CULTURAL SAFETY

Do Dance Academy is committed to creating an environment where Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children feel culturally safe, respected and included. We recognise and respect the diversity of children's identities, backgrounds and experiences and are committed to inclusive practices that support every child's wellbeing.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Do Dance Academy is committed to maintaining a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for all students, families and staff. This Code of Conduct outlines the expected standards of behaviour for students, parents, carers, staff and visitors while participating in Do Dance Academy activities.

All members of the Do Dance Academy community are expected to:

- Treat all children, families, staff and visitors with respect, dignity and fairness
- Support the safety, wellbeing and best interests of all children and young people
- Act in a manner that promotes a positive, inclusive and supportive environment
- Respect cultural diversity and individual differences
- Follow all studio policies, procedures and safety guidelines

Student Behaviour

Students are expected to:

- Show respect for themselves, others and their environment
- Follow teacher instructions and studio rules
- Behave in a manner that supports the safety and wellbeing of others
- Refrain from bullying, harassment or inappropriate behaviour (including physical, emotional, verbal or online behaviour)

Any inappropriate or unacceptable behaviour will be addressed in a fair and supportive manner and may result in parents being contacted. In serious or ongoing cases, appropriate action may be taken in line with studio policies, which may include suspension or dismissal.

Parent and Carer Behaviour

Parents and carers are expected to:

- Support a positive and respectful studio environment
- Communicate concerns respectfully and through appropriate channels
- Follow studio procedures for communication, pick-up and drop-off
- Respect the role and authority of staff and teachers

Parents and carers must not approach teachers or students during class time. All questions or concerns should be directed through reception or arranged via appointment with the Studio Principal.

Disrespectful, aggressive, defamatory or inappropriate behaviour towards students, families or staff — including online behaviour — will not be tolerated and may result in further action.

Staff, Contractors and Volunteers

All staff, contractors and volunteers at Do Dance Academy are required to:

- Act as positive role models at all times
- Maintain appropriate professional boundaries with students
- Use age-appropriate, respectful language and behaviour
- Ensure any physical contact is appropriate, necessary, explained and consent-based
- Avoid favouritism or exclusion
- Respect the cultural identity and needs of all children
- Follow all child safety, reporting and supervision requirements

All staff and volunteers hold current Blue Cards and are required to comply with Do Dance Academy's Child Safe & Wellbeing policies at all times.

Online and Social Media Behaviour

All members of the Do Dance Academy community are expected to:

- Use social media responsibly and respectfully
- Protect the privacy and dignity of children and families
- Refrain from posting content that is offensive, discriminatory, defamatory or harmful
- Follow Do Dance Academy's Social Media Policy at all times
- Breach of Code of Conduct

Breaches of this Code of Conduct will be managed fairly, confidentially and in accordance with Do Dance Academy policies. Outcomes may include guidance, further education, increased supervision, formal warnings or disciplinary action where appropriate.

Families who do not comply with their fee or payment obligations may be charged an administration fee and/or be excluded from class, performances and activities conducted by the studio. External debt collection may occur when fees remain overdue and this will be at the expense of the client. Costume expenses are the responsibility of the parents and costumes will not be issued to students with unpaid class fees.

Choreography, costuming and studio policies remain the intellectual property of Do Dance Academy and may not be reproduced or sold by any students, parents or staff without permission of the principal.

BEHAVIOUR

At Do Dance Academy, we are committed to fostering a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for all students. Students are expected to treat themselves, others and their environment with care and respect at all times and to follow studio rules and teacher instructions.

Behaviour that compromises the safety, wellbeing or enjoyment of others — including physical, emotional, verbal or online behaviour — will be addressed in a fair and supportive manner.

Parents and carers will be contacted where appropriate, and ongoing or serious concerns will be managed in line with Do Dance Academy policies, which may include suspension or dismissal in serious cases.

Parents and carers are encouraged to support positive behaviour and to model respectful communication at all times.

SAFETY

With the safety of our staff and families a number one priority, Do Dance Academy is very serious about upholding Child Protection laws and policies within the studio, as well as at public performances and in the online arena (website and social media).

As part of your registration, you will have read and signed a media waiver allowing us to proudly use images and video footage of your student for advertising and promotional purposes. Should you have any concerns whatsoever with signing this declaration, please see our reception staff who will happily assist you.

We have a number of parent viewing sessions within the studio rehearsal space which can be viewed by parents. All teachers and staff members have undergone official checks allowing them to work with children and all hold current First Aid Certificates.

The principal and staff at Do Dance Academy are educated in the negative impact of inappropriate music and costume selection when it comes to performing dance routines and are wholeheartedly committed to ensuring children in all dance routines are not subjected to any inappropriate songs or costuming. We recognise that songs with sexist, explicit, violent, racist, homophobic, or criminal content may influence our dancers and/or audience, and will strive to avoid using such music. We are committed to restricting costumes that project sexuality or contain explicit graphic or textual content.

Our staff members have all been trained in first aid. We enforce a nut-free policy at the studio to ensure the safety of all students or parents with allergies to nut or nut products.

Do Dance Academy take no responsibility for any stolen or misplaced property on the studio premises. We encourage our families and faculty members to avoid bringing valuable items into the studio where possible.

Students are covered under Do Dance Academy's Public Liability Insurance and while all due care is taken, we do also require that every student be covered by DanceSurance Australia. This cover is a Group Accident Cover and is \$18.75 per student/per year. This is added to the students first term's invoice. Please see the brochure below from DanceSurance with regards to the scope and benefits of this cover. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.

PRIVACY

When you purchase or hire a product or service with Do Dance Academy, the information we may collect from you includes your name, address, telephone numbers, email addresses, date of birth, medical information and perhaps credit card details. It may also include details of products and services we provide to you as well as the status of your enrolment. We only collect information directly from our students or their parent/guardians primarily for the purpose of providing services and products to you and to administer and manage invoicing and debt collection.

We may occasionally use your information to promote and market to you information which we consider may be of interest to you unless you contact us and tell us not to do so.

We will never sell or pass on any of your information to third parties unless required by government authorities or in the event of debt recovery. Any information passed on will be done so with appropriate privacy and confidentiality protection.

Information is stored securely in paper or electronic form and is accessible only by authorised personnel.

Identifying information about children — including names, age or location — must not be shared online.

Families are encouraged to raise any concerns regarding online content directly with the studio so they can be addressed promptly and appropriately.

GROUP ACCIDENT COVER

Dancing / Performing Australia wide in organised training sessions, competitions, displays, performances etc.

Travelling to/from their Dance / Performance activity; to/from their residence, school or place of employment.

Touring Worldwide for the purpose of participating in dancing or performing arts whilst representing their studio, club, organisation or National Body.

BENEFITS

Death and Disablement Benefits: Up to \$50,000 (Under 18 years of age \$10,000).

Medical Expenses: Non-Medicare medical expenses reimbursed up to \$2,000 per injury, including:

Ambulance, Chiropractic, Masseur, Private Hospital, Dental Service, Theatre Fees, Naturopath Osteopath Physiotherapy, Orthotics & Prosthesis

Note: a) *Non-Medicare Medical Expenses are reimbursed up to a maximum of 80% except physiotherapy which reimburses up to 95% of initial 5 visits, 80% of the next 6-10 visits and 75% of subsequent visits up to the overall limit of \$2,000 per claim.*

b) *Members who are not covered by Private Health Insurance are subject to a \$50 excess per claim.*

c) *Due to Government Legislation, members cannot be covered for any part of any "Medicare" e.g. Doctor, Surgeon, Anaesthetist, X-ray related account.*

CLOSED CLASSES

Do Dance Academy operates on a closed class system. Parents and friends are not permitted to sit in on class as it can be a distraction to both the students and the teachers. Please do not put the teachers in the awkward position of asking you to leave the room.

Parents may sit in on their son or daughter's **very first lesson only** at Do Dance Academy for ease of mind. We do invite parents to watch the **last lesson of each term** if they wish to observe their child's progress.

Parents are not required to wait onsite. However, there is seating available in the courtyard for your use if you would like to stay.

PARKING

Please take note of the car park signage. **THERE IS NO EXITING FROM THE CARPARK ONTO ROBINSON ROAD AT ANY TIME.** This is a safety rule implemented by the church and as tenants, we must abide by it. There is also NO parking in the yellow lined spaces as this is reserved as a drop off/pick up area for the childcare centre. We also ask that you do not park in any spaces that have been reserved specifically for others.

No children are to use the car park or grassed area for play. We ask that younger students are walked through the car park by a parent or guardian. All children must remain in the fenced area for their own safety.

Do Dance Academy provides supervision for students during their scheduled class times only. Parents and carers are responsible for the supervision of children before and after classes, including in the car park and surrounding areas.

UNIFORMS

At Do Dance Academy, uniforms help create a sense of belonging and pride within our studio community. Studio uniforms can be purchased year-round from reception.

General Attire Requirements

If a student is not wearing the official studio uniform, the following requirements apply:

- No loose-fitting T-shirts or shorts
- Hair must be securely tied back (bun or ponytail) with no hair covering the face
- Minimal jewelry only (studs or sleepers permitted)
- No necklaces, bracelets, watches or bangles
- Facial piercings must be covered and removed for performances
- Tattoos must be covered for performances

Class-Specific Attire

Little Stars Program

Program shirt, black bike pants/3/4 pants or black circular skirt. Ballet shoes with elastics (no ribbons).

Ballet

- Pre-Junior: Leotard, optional chiffon skirt, ballet tights or socks, pink ballet shoes with elastics
- Junior–Advanced: Leotard, pink ballet tights, pink ballet shoes with ribbons

Hair must be in a bun for all ballet classes.

Jazz / Musical Theatre

Fitted dancewear (no T-shirts or shorts). Camel jazz shoes (black jazz shoes required from Intermediate level).

Tap

Fitted dancewear. Camel tap shoes (black tap shoes from Grade 4 upwards). Tap shoes must not be worn on concrete or tiles or to and from class.

Acrobatics

Fitted dancewear only. No loose clothing or skirts. Bare feet.

Contemporary

Fitted dancewear. Natural tone foot thongs or bare feet.

Hip Hop

Hip hop shoes, jazz sneakers or sandshoes.

STAR DEVELOPEMENT FUND

Throughout the year, Do Dance Academy runs a range of fundraising activities to support our Star Development Fund. This fund was created to help further develop our students' abilities by making additional learning and performance opportunities outside the academy more accessible.

To date, the Star Development Fund has helped support students through Comdance examination workshops, eisteddfod fees, and financial assistance for families experiencing hardship, ensuring all children have the opportunity to continue their dance journey.

Fundraising activities planned for 2026 include our annual Cookie Dough Drive, Choreography Competition and Academy Disco. All profits from food and drink sales at reception also contribute directly to the fund.

The Star Development Fund will continue to support students in 2026 at a similar level to previous years. Further information about each fundraising activity will be shared throughout the year, and we sincerely thank our families for their ongoing support.

ANNUAL CONCERT 2026 –

Concert participation is not compulsory. However, you must inform the academy on your Concert Form if your child IS NOT performing in our annual concert. Concert participation forms are sent out on 16th February 2026 and are due back by **8th March 2026**. For costuming and class structure purposes, please inform the academy if you will be participating before 8th March 2026. Please note that no students will be accepted into concert past this date. If your child is performing, a certain amount of commitment and expense are required from both yourself and your child. Concert Information Meeting: This is for **ALL** parents/guardians of students even if you have attended a concert previously. In this meeting, all information regarding concert will be handed out and you will have the opportunity to ask questions. Non-attendance at one of these meetings with no notice given, will result in your son or daughter being withdrawn from concert. **This will be enforced!** There will be several meetings that you are able to attend these are listed below. You are only required to attend one of these allocated days/time.

Compulsory Photo Day: Sunday 7th June 2026 from 9:00am to 5:00pm. A timetable will be sent out indicating when the students need to be present for their individual and group photos. Venue for Photo Day will be Albany Creek State School (696 Albany Creek Rd, Albany Creek). There is no obligation to buy any photos however this day is **compulsory** for all students partaking in concert. Students will be required to have all hair, makeup and costumes on this day.

Compulsory Full-Dress & Stage Rehearsal:

Show 1 - Sunday 14th June 2026 – (Show #1 – Approx times 9.00am to 12.00pm). Times to be confirmed at Concert Information Meeting.

Show 2 – Sunday 21st June 2026 – (Show #2 – Approx times 9.00am - 5pm). Times to be confirmed at Concert Information Meeting.

Students will be required to have all hair, makeup and costumes on this day. Dress Rehearsal is a CLOSED rehearsal. No one is permitted to be in the theatre to watch. While this is a long day, supervision, breaks and activities are provided for the students. There is a per student Dress Rehearsal fee that is charged to help cover costs associated with Dress Rehearsal. This fee is depending on which show your Child is participating in. Show 1 is \$45.00 and Show 2 is \$60.00.

Costume Fees: Each item in concert will require a separate costume. Majority of these costumes will be hired to you at a cost of \$50.00 per costume/item. **All Costume money must be paid in full by the due date and before any costume is released.** Invoices for costuming will be sent home at a later date.

Additional costume requirements such as stockings and curly wig will need to be arranged by parents. More information for what each item requires is given out at our Concert Information Meeting and will be emailed to parents. Show 2 will require Do Dance Uniform Items for their Finale item. These can be purchased from Reception.

Concert Recording: Dance Vision will be videoing the annual concert this year. Each family of a participating student will receive a FREE copy of the Concert Recording via a digital download link. NO cameras will be permitted in the theatre due to the Do Dance Academy regulations and copyright law. Link for download will be available for collection at our Concert Viewing Night on the 18th July 2026. More information with regards to the downloadable link will be sent out closer to concert.

COMDANCE EXAMS

As a studio who values the growth and commitment of our dances from all ages, it is our pleasure to offer exams to students in Jazz, Ballet, Tap, Contemporary & Musical Theatre as part of our Commonwealth Society of Teachers of Dancing (Comdance) program. This year our exams will be held in October with the exact dates to be confirmed at a later date via email. We encourage all students who attend classes each week to enter for exams.

While exams are not compulsory, our Comdance syllabus is the most highly recognized dance syllabus worldwide. If your child is considering continuing to dance vocationally as they grow older, we strongly recommend completing your Comdance exams annually. Comdance exam results from Grade 4 onwards can count towards the Queensland Certificate of Education.

On a side note, our vast experience shows that formal exams present a unique opportunity for the children to display and take pride in how hard they work and are able to progress in their classes. Our exam students always find their exam experience to be uplifting, beneficial and rewarding.

As part of the exam preparation, exam dancers will also need to attend an intensive holiday workshop on 28th September 2026 – 3rd October 2026. More detailed information regarding this workshop will be sent out at a later date. Students wishing to sit modern jazz examinations from grade 3 upwards must be studying classical as a second subject.

There is a cost to partake in exams and payment for exams is due no later than 3rd August 2026 by PayPal, cash, cheque, credit card, EFTPOS or direct bank transfer. If you have not paid by this date, unfortunately your child will not be eligible.

More information regarding exams will be sent out at a later date.

ACROBATIC ARTS EXAMS

It is also our pleasure to offer exams to students in Acrobatics as part of our Acrobatic Arts program. Acrobatic Arts syllabus is the most highly recognized acrobatic syllabus worldwide. Developed in Canada in consultation with Cirque Du Soleil. Acrobatic Arts offers a comprehensive training program for dancers to safely learn AcroDance. The curriculum covers anatomy, technique, progressions, choreography, and more!

As part of the exam preparation, exam dancers will also need to attend an intensive holiday workshop on 28th September 2026 – 3rd October 2026. More detailed information regarding this workshop will be sent out at a later date. Students wishing to sit acrobatic arts examinations must take an extra examination only class. This year our exams will be held in October with the exact dates to be confirmed at a later date via email.

There is a cost to partake in exams and payment for exams is due no later than 3rd August 2026 by PayPal, cash, cheque, credit card, EFTPOS or direct bank transfer. If you have not paid by this date, unfortunately your child will not be eligible.
